IOM Recommendation #1

Nurses should practice to the full extent of their education and training.

National Consensus Model

- Standardize education within APRN disciplines
- Ensure educational program quality
- Improve patient access to care regardless of geography
- Improve interstate mobility of APRNs
- Better meet current & future APRN workforce needs

Advisory Committee work plan

- First step: review model statute & rules
- Second step: identify gaps
- Next step: reach consensus
- Final step: make recommendations
